

My Confirmation Scrapbook

You are required to create a physical scrapbook that chronicles your personal journey to preparing and celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation. We have listed a selection of items that must be included. Feel free to add additional information. Be creative. Add photos where you can. This is a fun assignment that shows your path to becoming a disciple and a soldier for Christ.

- **Students attending St. Cecilia CES, St. Raphael the Archangel CES, public, private and other schools will hand in this assignment at any Mass the weekend of March 25th or 26th, 2023.**

Masses times are as follows: Saturdays 4:00 pm and Sundays 10:00 am & 11:30 am

What to include in your scrapbook:

(Each of the following should take up one or two pages in your scrapbook.)

1. About You (short biography)
 - Name of your parent(s)/guardians
 - What are their jobs?
 - What is their heritage?
 - Siblings? How many? Are they younger or older than you?
 - Are they still in school or do they work?
 - Where were you born?
 - Where were you Baptized – country and name of Parish?
 - Where did you receive your First Holy Communion?
2. Nicene Creed – a statement of faith that you believe in God and the Holy Trinity
 - In your own words, who is the Holy Spirit?
3. Renewal of Baptismal Promises – What are your Baptismal Promises?
4. What are the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit? Show or explain what they mean to you.
5. What are the Nine Fruits of the Holy Spirit?
6. Who is your Patron Saint? Who is your favourite Saint?
 - What does that Saint mean to you?
 - What is that Saint known for?
 - What cause are they the Patron Saint of?
 - Do they have a famous quote?
7. What is your favourite Bible verse and why?
8. A letter from your sponsor
 - This letter should include:
 - What it means to your Sponsor to Confirm you.
 - How they feel about being your sponsor.
 - A precious memory they have of or with you.
 - A brief description of your relationship
 - Words of wisdom/advice
 - This letter should be sealed with your name on it – you are to open it on the day of your Confirmation Mass.

The Parish Office will return assignments to the students attending either St. Cecilia CES or St. Raphael the Archangel CES directly through their respective school. All other students are to collect their assignment at weekend Mass from the Welcome Desk the week following the due date.
